### Vintage Summary

The 2012 Thomas Henry Zinfandel is vinified in a traditional method of regular pump-overs to extract fine dark color, firm flavor tannins and dark cherry and briary berry flavors. The wine is pressed firmly to extract the deeper tannins in the skins and then aged in a blend of 30% new French and Pennsylvania oak with the remainder in neutral Hungarian oak barrels. The wine is typically bottled within 16 to 18 months.
