2016 Barossa and Eden Valleys Shiraz

The Barossa & Eden Valleys Shiraz epitomises the philosophy of Powell & Son: to marry the strengths of the Barossa and Eden Valleys together.

The 2016 Barossa & Eden Shiraz is complex with lifted violets and bramble, offset by dark berry fruits and mincemeat.

The wine is opulent and dense but maintains lifted natural acidity and red fruits to give freshness to the finish.

Varietal: 100% Shiraz
Region: Barossa Valley and Eden Valley
Districts: Western Barossa Valley and Eden Valley
Soil: Brown loams over ironstone; dark schists over clay
Vines: 40 - 70+ years old
Harvest: 4th March, 9th April
pH: 3.59
TA: 5.5 g/l
Alcohol: 14.5%

Vinification:

Components are vinified separately in open-top concrete vats and pumped over twice daily. The fruit is then basket pressed and sent to 4,500L French oak Foudre for wild malolactic fermentation and 15 months maturation. The components are then combined and sent to bottle without fining or filtration.



Drink now or over the next 20 years. Works well with big meat dishes with heavy reduction sauces.
