## 2016 Kraehe Shiraz

*The 2016 Kraehe jumps from the glass with stewed plum, freshly turned earth and olive tapenade.*

*The palate is dark and profound with flavours of sweet cherry, blackberry jam and blood plum.*

*The tannins are silken and lifted by a fresh and lively acid backbone ensuring a long life ahead.*

*155 dozen produced*

Varietal: 100% Shiraz  
Region: Barossa Valley  
District: Marananga – 230 metre altitude  
Aspect: Gentle Easterly slope  
Soil: Dark red brown loam over ironstone  
Vines: 100 years old  
Harvest: 10<sup>th</sup> March  
pH: 3.63  
TA: 5.8 g/l  
Alcohol: 14.5%

### Vinification:

Fermented in open-top concrete vats. Pumped over twice daily.  
Basket pressed, wild malolactic fermentation in barrel and matured in French oak barrique for 22 months prior to bottling without fining or filtration.



Drink now or over the next 20-30 years. Works well with beef, venison or matured hard cheeses.
