2016 Riverside GMS

The 2016 Riverside is pronounced with its aromas of ripe kirsch, glace cherry and plum.

The palate is soft, rich and delicately textured with signature mataro tannin maintaining a frame.

Varietal: 37% Grenache, 33% Mataro, 30% Shiraz

Region: Barossa Valley

Districts: Lyndoch

Soil: Deep Brown Loams

Vines: Average of 20 years old

Harvest: 6th April

pH: 3.55

TA: 5.8 g/l

Alcohol: 14.5%

Vinification:

All varieties from the Riverside vineyard are vinified separately, being fermented in concrete vats and pumped over. Post fermentation half of the Grenache component is matured in stainless steel and the Mataro and Shiraz is matured in 4,500 French oak Foudre for 15 months prior to bottling without fining or filtration.

Drink now or over the next 7 years.
