
Stix Alexander Valley Cabernet Sauvignon



The legendary Alexander Valley is notorious for producing some of the most complex Cabernet Sauvignon in the New World. With hot days and cool nights, the grapes ripen evenly resulting in rich tannins and superior color, and bright acidity.

We farm our Alexander Valley vineyards with these climate conditions in mind. By managing the canopies correctly, we encourage exposure to the sun and cooling breezes, resulting in a intense color and aromas.

Our exceptional vineyards within the appellation, River East and Soda Rock Vineyards, combine to make this Cabernet Sauvignon rich with soft tannins that this area is noted for. Rolling hills of rocky, loam soils and valleys with deep gravely soil, produce grapes that are packed with rich chocolate and cassis flavors, with layers of dark cherries. Aging in French and American oak for 15 months imparts additional layers of tannin and vanilla enhancing the wines complexity.
