

Domaine Jean-Claude Bachelet et Fils



The Bachelet family has been making wine in Burgundy since the 17th century. Jean-Baptiste and Benoit Bachelet are now the primary wine-makers at the family domaine. All of the vineyards are estate owned and they produce wines from some of the top sites in Saint-Aubin, Chassagne-Montrachet and Puligny-Montrachet. The domaine is composed of 9 hectares, 47% of the vineyards are in Chassagne-Montrachet, 40% are in Saint-Aubin and the remaining 13% are from Puligny-Montrachet. Today they continue to represent the highest quality of wine available from these world famous regions.

Saint-Aubin 1er Cru Blanc

Slightly pale gold green bouquet combining green almond, the marzipan (or almond paste), beeswax, amber and a touch of pepper flavors. The finesse and elegance bring harmony to the palate.

Fine cuisine will partner with the white wines of Saint-Aubin: fish in cream sauce, puff pastry, foie gras, white meats, strong cheeses.
