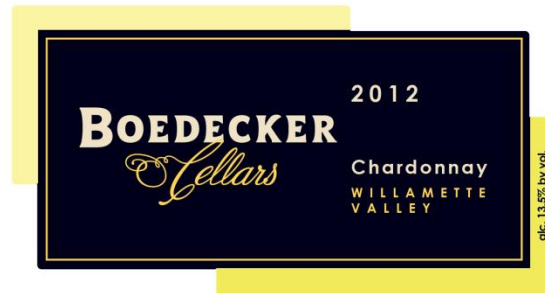


Chardonnay

VINEYARD

Finnigan Hill Vineyard lies high up in the Chehalem Mountain AVA. The volcanic subsoil and high elevation allows the fruit to achieve flavor ripeness while preserving vibrant acidity.

WINEMAKING

Whole cluster and gently slow pressed in our small 1.5 ton press. After 24 hours the juice was racked into neutral French barrels for fermentation and élevage. Fermentation progressed slowly at low temperatures through mid-December with partial ml. The barrels were stirred (bâtonnage) throughout élevage, and the wines were bottled late summer.

THE BLEND

Finnigan Hill Vineyard, Chehalem Mountain: Dijon 95

TASTING NOTES

Bright fruit notes of pear, melon and citron blossom all balance on a smooth core of restrained minerality, completing with a long silky finish.
