

## Château Cissac Haut Medoc

Type of vats: french wood-oak.

 $\pmb{Ageing}$ : 30% / 40% new oak are used every year.In oak casks for 18/20

months.

**The Vines:** At Château Cissac, these extend over 50 hectares. It is from these vines that the "grand vin" is produced, Château Cissac and its

"second wine", Reflets du Château Cissac.

Size of the vineyard: 50 hectares

**Soil**: fine gravel over chalk

**CULTIVATION** 

Grape varieties: 75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Merlot, 5% Petit

Verdot

Average age of vines: 30 years

PRoot stock: 3309, 161-49, Riparia Gloire

Planting density: 7200 vines per hectare

Average production per hectare: 54 hectos

**Antibotritis treatment:** yes

Grape-picking: by hand

Each vine variety does not produce similar quantities each year. However the proportions on the various single-variety wines that are assembled to make Château Cissac are strictly respected. The remaining wines are then carefully blended and are offered to customers under the label "Reflets du Château Cissac".

The style will undoubtedly vary from year to year, not only for climatic reasons which apply to all wines but also to the varying proportions of grape-varieties.
