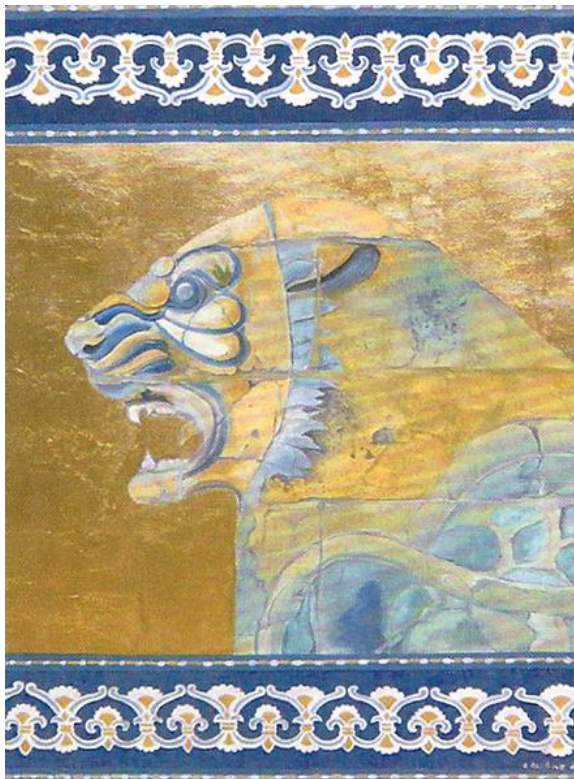


## DIDIER DAGUENEAU "LES JARDINS DE BABYLONE JURANCON" (dry)

This 7.4 acres vineyard of Les Jardins de Babylone is situated on terraces in the hills near the village of Aubertin. The wines produced from these vineyards are notably famous for their special vividness. With the precious help from Guy Pautrat, Louis-Benjamin Dagueneau works tirelessly to bring the same level of exceptional care to the vineyard as he does to his vineyards in Sancerre and Pouilly-Fume. After the grapes are harvested and sorted by hand, the grapes are then fermented in new oak barrels (half size cask). Low in alcohol and with a large finesse, these wines have a special spirit which is more Germanic in nature.



This dry aromatic jurançon reveals excellent depth which is a result of a meticulous cultivation and vinification process. It stands out from other dry wines of the appellation by its intensity and weight (due to the low acidity of Camaralet) on the palate while revealing a tantalizing display of fruits characteristic of the 2012 vintage. Beginning to open it in 4 or 5 years.
