



## Familia Mayol Cuatros Primos Blend 2012

### Winemaker's Notes

Malbec as the anchor provides velvety and medium sweet tannins. The final result is a wine that surrenders a brooding bouquet exhibiting notes of wood smoke, mineral, Asian spices, incense, graphite and assorted black fruits. In the glass it has a racy personality, complexity, and good volume and length. This savory effort will benefit from 2-3 years of additional cellaring before the wine is released.

### Stephen Tanzer's International Wine Cellar

"The 2012 Cuatro Primos Blend is a blend of 50% Malbec, 35% Syrah, 10% Bonarda and 5% Petit Verdot from the Uco Valley, aged for one year in second and third-use French oak barrels. Even though the smoky and charred notes are still quite evident, the palate displays good, ripe and concentrated fruit with polished, sophisticated tannins, and sweetness, probably from the sheer concentration of fruit. A big, modern, impressive wine."
