

Francois Mikulski Bourgogne rouge



This wine comes from two old plots, the Lombois and the Durots, which are not really productive anymore today but still confer a great strength and character to the red Bourgogne Pinot Noir.

This is a wine with supple tannins, a dominance of red fruits (blackberry jelly, blackcurrant, violet aromas), subtle and elegant. It may be aged, but we would recommend drinking it quite young in order to fully appreciate its silky character. It will be a perfect pairing with tasty red meat.
