Picking date: September 17th & 22nd, 2014

Harvest Data: 24.3 brix, pH 3.36, TA 5.1

Cold Soaked: 6 days

Fermentation: Spontaneous native fermentation, gentle punch downs or pump over twice per day

Pressed: October 6th

Barreled: October 8th with 30% New French Oak

Malolactic fermentation: Indigenous and 100% complete by June 4th, 2015

Bottled: March 2nd, 2016

2014 TASTING NOTES

Shiny and ruby red with purple hues, the first nose reveals fresh cherries with a hint of dusty rose petals and exotic spice: cinnamon, mace and nutmeg. It quickly opens up to reveal fresh strawberry pie and pomegranate nose, laced with red currants, bergamot & floral notes. Smooth, light and velvety on the palate, with fresh berry notes coating and restrained; and savory spice notes lingering on the long finish. A wine of a silky open texture and giving.
