Vintage Conditions

Every vintage brings its share of surprises and challenges, and after a precocious 2014 and a solar 2015, 2016 was once again a one-of-a-kind crop, quite challenging, but eventually yielding great wines. The wines are extremely fresh, showing character, pure fruit aromas wrapped around beautifully structuring acidities. They are already seductive but give also great promise for aging. Truly a one-of-a-kind vintage that rendered great achievements, but also some great lessons. beautifully.

About the Wine

A dry, fresh, fruity, lively wine with very good body and personality. The grapes are sourced entirely from the domaine’s estate vineyard, Clos de Capuchins.

Tasting Note

Typical nose of bubble gum but with more citrus notes than usual. There are some notes of anise, vanilla bean, and banana on the palate. The wine is sweet, salty, and quite complex for the varietal.

Food Pairing

Delightful with hors d’oeuvres, charcuterie, oysters, and light dishes.
