Bourgogne Pinot Noir

Vine

The Burgundy Pinot Noir vineyards we cultivate belong to Marie Pierre and François Mikulski. They cover a total area of 1.30 hectares. The first was planted in 1929 and the second in 1980.

Their vines are 100% Pinot Noir. Annual production: around 6,000 bottles.

The vines are cultivated using non-certified organic methods.

The soil

The subsoil consists of fine alluvial river sediment, which is common on the lower part of the slope.

Ageing

The vintage is aged in oak barrels for about 10 months, then drawn off and put in tanks for 2 months before bottling.

Tasting

We advise ageing these bottles for a while (4 to 5 years).

This is a wine for drinking as an accompaniment to grilled meats.
