

DOMAINE Hubert LAMY - Hubert et Olivier LAMY

Area : Chassagne-Montrachet - Côte d'Or - Bourgogne – France

Winemakers in Saint Aubin since 1640, Hubert created the winery in 1973 from 9ha. His son, Olivier, has worked with him since 1998. Today, father and son farm 45.7 acres of which 26.7 acres are “Premiers crus” like Saint Aubin, Puligny Montrachet, Chassagne Montrachet and Santenay.



Area: 2.30 acres

Soil: Deep and clay. South-East exposure

Origin: Means an enclosed orchard surrounded by a hedge

Grape variety: Chardonnay

Ages: vines planted in 2005, 2010 and 2016

Vine-growing: No fertilizer used for 16 years but some organic compost are added.

Low yield. All the vineyards are treated using low doses of natural products, sulfur or copper. This is known in French as *lutte raisonnée* (treatment with products that respect the existing flora and which are applied only when necessary). The Soil is plowed about 4 times a year.

Vinification: Harvest by hand.

Fermentation in barrels (300 l) and half hogshead (600l). Controlled temperature in barrels. Long fermentation: 90 days

Tasting: Yellow green color. Fine and subtle nose with yellow fresh fruits. Fresh palate. Good balance between freshness and maturity. Fantastic length of minerality.

Aging potential: Drink between 2017 and 2021
